Main Purpose

MSF OCG counts more than 7000 employees (600 international staff, 6000 national staff) in around 25 countries. In 2018 only, OCG (Operational Centre Geneva) has sent 1'382 expatriates in missions. In 2018, the field recruitment team has received some 3653 applications and have carried out 178 final interviews.

As a **Field Recruiter**, you will directly contribute to answering OCG's medico-operational needs by recruiting diverse medical or para medical profiles, willing to work internationally in our various fields of intervention. Such profiles will vary from paramedical (Nurses, Midwifes, Pharmacist,...) to medical specialists (Obstetricians/gynaecologists, Surgeons, Anaesthetists).

To ensure that the right profiles are recruited at the right time in order to answer OCG operational needs in all contexts! You will ensure a diverse pool of candidates, ready to answer emergencies, planned or unplanned needs.

You will be in charge of:

Sourcing

- In collaboration with selected MSF partners worldwide, ensures OCG's Sourcing Strategy and guarantees diversity in recruitment sources.
- For MSF Switzerland, in collaboration with HR Marketer, identifies and uses diverse sources of recruitment in order to receive targeted profiles (schools, associations, social media, digital networks...), with a specific drive for critical positions.
- Actively participates in HR Marketing event (forums, job fairs, presentations, info session...)

Active Recruitment

- In collaboration with technical referents and pool managers, ensures the overall compliance and quality of the field recruitment process
- Manages the full recruitment cycle for applications, including the overview of those coming from selected MSF partners.
- Supports fellow recruiters in the recruitment for other profiles when needed (Logistics, Medical, Administration, communication, Advocacy), and contributes to the team's understanding of paramedical and medical specialists specificities (diploma, educational background,...)
